Greetings from MGMI!

This is to inform that E-Voting for the election of the Council Members of **MINING GEOLOGICAL & METALLURGICAL INSTITUTE OF INDIA** for the period 2025-2028 will be held starting at 9:00 AM on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. It will be open for a period of 30 days and close at 5:00 PM on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2025. CDSL has been assigned to conduct the election.

CDSL will provide the **EVSN (unique code for MGMI Election), USER ID and Unique codes** to log in to the **E-voting Portal**, as well as the procedure and steps for e-voting in electronic mode (e-mail) to **members eligible to vote and whose email addresses are registered with MGMI**.

The e-mail will be sent **three times** from CDSL ([gogreen@cdslindia.com](mailto:gogreen@cdslindia.com)) to the **e-mail address registered/1<sup>st</sup> e-mail address (in case 2 addresses are registered with MGMI), one initial e-mail on Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025** and thereafter, **1<sup>st</sup> reminder e-mail on Friday, 22<sup>th</sup> August 2025** and **2<sup>nd</sup> Reminder on Friday, 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025**. It is requested that in case more than one e-mails are registered, all e-mails on those dates (including **spam folder & in case of Gmail – the Social, Promotions & Social folders** too) may be checked if the e-mail from CDSL is not received till Friday, **5<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.

**The responsibility of providing an e-mail address or correct/active e-mail address lies with the member and not MGMI. MGMI will forward the 1<sup>st</sup> e-mail address registered with MGMI. MGMI is not bound to send this letter in a hard copy as per E-voting procedure manual of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs but utmost efforts will be taken to reach all eligible voting members.**

MGMI encourages the members to cast their votes for all the 11 vacancies in its Council for which the election is being held. **Single voting is discouraged.** Members who are voting should look at the larger interests of MGMI and not of an individual candidate.

It must be ensured that the vote is cast during the E-voting period between **9:00 AM on Thursday, the 28<sup>th</sup> of August, 2025 and 5:00 PM on Friday, the 26<sup>th</sup> of September, 2025.** Beyond this period, the **E-voting Window will be closed.**

  - d. In the e-voting page accessed through MGMI website or after direct visit, please click on **"Shareholders/Members"** option.
  - e. Now please enter your **USER ID** (your MGMI Membership Number with a prefix 'MGMI') provided by CDSL to your e-mail address through their email id [gogreen@cdslindia.com](mailto:gogreen@cdslindia.com) on 8.8.2025 (1<sup>st</sup> reminder on 22.8.2025 & 2<sup>nd</sup> reminder on 5.9.2025).
  - f. Next enter the Image Verification as displayed and **Click on Login**.
  - g. Please enter the **PASSWORD** as provided by CDSL.
  - h. After entering these details appropriately, please click on **"SUBMIT"** tab.
  - i. Next, please click on the **EVSN which is same for all in this E-voting event (Value will be provided in email sent with individual USER ID and PASSWORD for e-voting)** pertaining to the MGMI Election on this page.
  - j. The voting page for MGMI Council members will open.
  - k. On the voting page, you will see **"LIST OF THE MEMBERS TO BE VOTED ON"** and against the same, the option for Check box for voting. Select the **11** members you want to vote for (out of the **17** possible candidates who are standing for election to the Council).
  - l. After selecting the members, you have decided to vote on, please click on **"SAVE"**. A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish **to confirm your vote, please click on "OK"**, else **to change your vote, please click on "CANCEL"** and accordingly modify your

vote. If you **modify**, please repeat the process, confirm by clicking on “OK” and then **click SUBMIT**”. Your voting is complete.

m. **Once you confirm your vote on the candidates selected, you will not be allowed to modify.**

n. If you have voted for less than 11 persons, and want to vote for more, you may do the same again after logging in until the time you vote for 11 candidates.

*E.g., If you have voted for 5 candidates and need time to think and check on remaining 6 vacancies, you can do so after logging in again with the same process and same credentials, and vote on 6 more candidates from the remaining 12 available nominations. The previous 5 votes that have been cast cannot be changed and the radio buttons against their names will be disabled.*

4. You will receive emails from [gogreen@cdslindia.com](mailto:gogreen@cdslindia.com) thrice from CDSL on your e-mail id registered with MGMI - **One initial mail on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025** and thereafter **1st Reminder e-mail on 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025** and **2<sup>nd</sup> Reminder email on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.
5. Each voter will have to select **maximum 11 candidates out of the 17 candidates** in the fray. In case the voter has selected 11 candidates, system will prompt and will not allow submission of the vote if him/her wants to select more. No of candidates voted for is kept at a maximum of 11 candidates. MGMI encourages the members to cast their votes for all the 11 vacancies in its Council for which the election is being held. Single voting is discouraged. Members who are voting should look at the larger interests of MGMI and not of an individual candidate.
